THE MATCH-UP: Both teams are entering this contest searching for their first win of the season. The Bears opened the 2005 campaign facing the number six team in Division II Carson-Newman and their arch rivals St. Augustine's and came up short in both outings. The Tigers ran into a seasoned N.C. Central team and Division I-AA Samford University.

Offense for both teams have been a major question mark, but the Bears are the ones that have produced the best numbers between the two. EWC is only averaging 102 yards per game in total offense, while the Bears are averaging 319 yards per game. The Tigers are averaging 15.5 yards per game on the ground and surprisingly the Bears are only averaging 49.5 yards per game. It's a big surprise for the Bears because they are returning two All-CIAA running backs, Dion McIver and Byron Cary. McIver rushed for over 1,000 yards last season and Cary rushed for over 900 yards in 2003. Something has to give this Saturday with the Bears looking to right the ship by playing the brand of football that won them a CIAA title last season, while the Tigers are trying to grow up quickly. With 52 freshmen on the roster, the Tigers have been suffering with inexperience.

THE SERIES: This is the fourth meeting between the Bears and the Tigers in a series that kicked off in 2002. The Bears are leading the series 2-1 and have won the last two match-ups. The Tigers won 31-10 in the first meeting, which was the Bears club season, their first year back on the gridiron. The Bears defeated the Tigers 21-7 in 2003 and 21-12 last year.

THE COACHES: The Shaw University Bears are coached by Deondri Clark (Florida State, 1993). He is in his third season with a 17-7 (.708%) record. The Edward Waters Tigers are coached by Lamont Massie (Tuskegee, 1990), who is in his fifth year at the helm. Including this season Coach Massie has a 23-21 (.522%) record. Massey has coached the Tigers since the return of football in 2001.

SCORING STREAK - Since the return of football on the NCAA Division II level, the Bears had a 23 game streak of not being shut-out until last weekend's game. Going back to the club year that streak was 32 games.

NON-CONFERENCE ACTION IS BIG THIS WEEK

So far this season the CIAA has not had success outside of the conference, especially in NCAA Division II Regional action. The CIAA's biggest rival in the region is the SAC and going into this weekend, they are 5-0 against the CIAA. This weekend that could change big with three big matchups, Catawba at Virginia St., NC Central at Lenoir Rhyne and St. Augustine's at Mars Hill.

BEARS HAVE IMPRESSIVE DIVISIONAL RECORD -

In two years the Bears have seen great success in the CIAA East. Since their return, they are 10-4 in CIAA Eastern Division competition.

LAST WEEK

It was all St. Augustine's College in the match-up of Raleigh's two CIAA rivals, as the Falcons shut out the Shaw University Bears 33-0. This was the first shut out the Bears have suffered since the return of football in 2002. This is also the worst start for the Bears since the return of football. The positive point for the Bears is the game did not count in the conference race and with 19 returning starters from last year's title run; they have the opportunity to get back into the hunt. The win improved the Falcons to 2-0 and the Bears dropped to 0-2.

To start, the ball definitely didn't bounce in Shaw U's favor or it should be said, the Bears could not hold onto the ball. The Bears had four turnovers (1-fum./3int) and two dozen dropped passes. The Falcons held the Bears to 141 yards of total offense, and 34 yards on the ground. On the other hand, the Falcons finished the afternoon with 412 yards of total offense.

Bears senior running back **Dion McIver** (6'0, 201/ Lillington, NC) finished the afternoon with 46 yards on 12 carries and quarterback **Jermonty Kimbrough** (5'11, 190/ Mobile, AL) completed 17 of 45 passes for 107 yards.

HEAD COACH

SU's Deondri Clark is in his third year at the helm and including this season he is sporting an impressive 17-7 (.708%) record. In just two years, Clark has become one of

the top young coaches in the country, guiding SU to a CIAA Eastern Division second place finish in 2003 and last year winning the CIAA title and the Pioneer Bowl.

Clark was named head coach on September 3, 2003 and the 7-3 finish his first season was the Bears best record in 33 years. Clark is a 1993 graduate of Florida State and a native of Winter Garden, FL. He was a standout defensive lineman for the Seminoles and legendary Coach Bobby Bowden. Present N.C. State head coach Chuck Amato was his position coach during his days at Florida State. During his collegiate career at FSU they won four Bowl games and had an impressive 42-7 record. FSU never finished less than #4 in the national AP rankings during his career.

In 2002, Clark was SU's defensive coordinator and prior to his tenure at SU, he was the defensive line coach at Benedict College (2001-02). Prior to Benedict he was a graduate assistant at Michigan State (200-01 and Central Michigan (1999-2000). He earned his master's of arts degree from Central Michigan in 2003.
